

# Learning Continuity Plan Term 4 2020

A school wide approach to transitioning from remote learning to onsite learning.

Dear Edi Upper Primary School Parents and Staff,

On behalf of our school, I want to say a big thank you to all our students, parents and staff for your continued resilience and support throughout the year. I know remote and flexible learning has been a challenge, but through our collective efforts, our students have continued to make valuable progress in their learning. Our students will continue to be supported in their wellbeing, learning and transition back into full time onsite schooling.

Please read below for more detail as to how Term 4 will operate at our school. Please note that as the school term progresses, parents and students will be advised of any upcoming changes:

## From Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October...

- Students will need to wear their school hats at school during Term 4.
- Temperature checking before the students enter the school will not continue this term. **If your child is ill or is feeling unwell, they must not attend school,** they must remain home and seek medical advice.
- To support the health and wellbeing of all our students and staff, our school has an enhanced cleaning routine and will continue to encourage frequent hand washing.
- Masks need to be worn if you need to exit your car to collect your child from the school bus.
- The students need to bring their own water bottle to use at school. Staff will refill these if they are empty.
- Parents and volunteers are still not able to be onsite at this stage. If you need to collect your child from school, please either ring the school or text the school mobile beforehand so a staff member can bring them out to the gate.
- School staff are running the cooking program for our students only.
- We are able to go on excursions and overnight camps.
- School Council meetings will continue to be run via WebEx Meetings.
- We cannot hold a 'normal' end of year concert i.e. everyone attending in one place. However, we will be filming the student's items and home-grown play which will be available on our website to view. More information later in the term.

## How will school staff support your child's return to onsite learning at school?

### Teachers will:

- Allow time for your child to settle back into full time onsite schooling
- Continue to do some whole class activities to build friendships and social skills
- Support your child in consolidating any areas that they have struggled in re reading, writing and mathematics
- Use a different way of presenting end of year reports to reflect your child's remote learning activities in Term 3.

Our school, working with you, has shown it can be flexible and adaptable in responding to the challenges of coronavirus. We will continue to meet students' needs as we look towards the end of the 2020 school year and ahead to 2021.
